

Terms and Conditions for Conferences and Workshops

1. Subject

The terms and conditions below govern the contractual relationship between the participants in seminars, courses and conferences (hereinafter "Event") and the Global Risk Forum GRF Davos. Different Terms and Conditions of the participant shall not be valid.

2. Registration

With an electronic registration via ConfTool or a written enrollment, the conference participants agrees with our terms and conditions and our cancellation policy. The registration becomes legally binding upon written confirmation (by email) by GRF Davos

3. Obligation

Registration fees are charged per person and event date. GRF Davos reserves the right to substitute speakers announced by others, and to make necessary changes to the event program, while maintaining the overall character of the event. GRF Davos is committed to do everything reasonable to resolve or mitigate a eventual disturbance.

4. Prices and Payment conditions

The listed prices are in CHF, include the legal VAT and any other charges and are binding. GRF Davos reserves the right to a price adjustment for reasons we can not influence (such as currency fluctuations, newly introduced and increased taxes).

5. Cancellation

Cancellations must be done in writing. In case of a rejected visa application, the entire registration fee, minus a handling charge of CHF 100.- will be reimbursed to the conference participants from countries requiring a visa. If you cancel up to four weeks before the event, the entire registration fee will be refunded, minus a handling fee of CHF 100.-. At a later date, no refunds will be paid.

6. Substitute People

If you are prevented to participate, you can send a substitute person. If a new visa application must be submitted or other work has to be done by GRF Davos (eg, inclusion in the list of participants, new badge, etc.) an additional handling fee of CHF 100.- will be charged.

7. Liability

The events are prepared and conducted to the best of GRF Davos' knowledge and belief through qualified staff, authors and speakers. GRF Davos, however, assumes no liability for the timeliness, accuracy and completeness of speeches and conference documents and for the implementation of the event.

8. Applicable law, Place of Jurisdiction and Performance

Swiss law is applicable. Place of performance and jurisdiction is Davos.

9. Privacy Policy

GRF Davos protects the personal information of participants and uses them only in accordance with the privacy regulations. Personal data is all data that is stored in connection with the names of the participants. GRF Davos makes best efforts for the safety of your data. The information data submitted by participants (first name, last name, shipping and billing address, e-mail address, depending on the method of payment and bank account, credit card number, expiration date of the credit card) will be saved by GRF Davos, and used in subscriber or customer lists and processed for the purpose of providing the service and billing, - if necessary – passed to service providers instructed by GRF.
